Alumnae Membership Class

1. Purpose.
An Alumnae Membership class benefits both our membership and our organization. It creates an official status for members desiring a more subsidiary role after their children reach school age, allowing them to remain comfortable connected to our organization. By the same token, these more experienced members contribute to the stability and continuity essential to preserving the character of our organization.
2. Non-Mandatory.
Alumnae Membership is self-selecting and voluntary. Members have no obligation to become Alumnae because their children have reached school age. Rather, they are encouraged to maintain an active Regular Membership for as long as they desire, regardless of their children's ages.
3. Eligibility.
 - a. Regular members are eligible for Alumnae Membership if:
 - i. They have maintained Regular Membership status for 4 years, whether or not consecutive; and
 - ii. One of their children has reached the age of 7 years.
 - b. Members may re-join our organization as Alumnae regardless of the amount of the time that may have elapsed since maintaining Regular Membership, as long as eligibility requirements are met.
4. Member Benefits.
 - a. Alumnae Member benefits are the same as those for Regular Members except:
 - i. Two events are held each year specifically for Alumnae
 - ii. Alumnae receive as needed mailings with notice of key organizational events; and
 - iii. Alumnae do not receive a newsletter
 - b. Alumnae can purchase a newsletter subscription for an annual amount representing the difference between the dues for Alumnae Members and the dues for the Regular Members.

5. Board Representation.
